eir is delighted to announce that it has secured a range of additional Irish broadcasting rights to various sporting events and competitions.

Commenting on the announcement, eir Sport CEO Mickey O'Rourke, said "We are delighted to have secured all the Republic of Ireland rights to the 2019 Rugby World Cup in Japan. We broadcast all 48 games live in 2007 and 2011 and it's great to know we will be doing the same again in 2019. We are very thankful to World Rugby for entrusting us with these rights along with the U-20's Championship, the Women's World Cup and Sevens rights. It's a fantastic way to launch the new eir Sport brand."

eir is the principal provider of fixed-line and mobile telecommunications services in Ireland with more than 836,000 direct and indirect broadband connections, and more than 1,000,000 mobile customers through the eir and Meteor brands. eir has the most extensive network across the country both in terms of capacity and geographic reach.

In December 2015, eir acquired Setanta Sports Channel Ireland Ltd and the Irish rights to BT Sport for an undisclosed sum. It is Ireland's leading premium sports broadcaster.

eir has spent €1.3 billion on capital investment over the past four years to enhance fixed and mobile network infrastructure, the largest investment programme of any provider in the country. It will deliver better quality broadband and data services for consumers and businesses of all sizes right across the country. Fibre broadband has been built to 1.6m homes and businesses today, using both fibre to the cabinet (FTTC) and fibre to the home (FTTH) technologies. Rollout will reach 1.9 million by 2020.

The eir Sport pack comprises six channels of great sporting content including Barclays Premier League Football, FA Cup, Champions League, Europa League, top flight European football from Germany, Italy and France, League of Ireland, European Rugby Champions Cup, Aviva Premiership Rugby, UFC, Formula One, Allianz Leagues GAA and much more.

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
