

eir Mobile Broadband – Feb 16

1. These terms and conditions of the eir Mobile Bill Pay Broadband Service ("the Service") are in addition to the Terms and Conditions of the eir Mobile Service, which are set out at www.eir.ie/termsandconditions . In the event of any conflict these terms and conditions will prevail.
2. The Service is subject to a minimum contract period of 30 days or 6 months, depending on purchased tariff plan.
3. Customers may use the Service to browse, or download from the internet to a limit specified in purchased tariff plan of data per month for a price specified in purchased tariff plan. Any usage in excess of the tariff plan allowance is subject to a charge of 2c for every additional MB used.
4. In Order to avail of the 4G Service, Customers must be using a 4G compatible device and a 4G SIM. A list of 4G compatible devices and applicable prices is as set out on eir.ie
5. Customers can only avail of 4G Service when they are operating the service in areas in which the 4G coverage is available. eir displays a map which gives an indicative guide to those areas where 4G coverage is available and can be accessed by clicking <https://www.eir.ie/ourmobilenetwork/>.
6. When operating the service in a location where the 4G service is not available, 3G service will be provided.
7. If you are in a 4G compatible region, 4G speeds may vary depending on the number of other people using the network at once. As with other existing mobile phone services, coverage can change in tunnels, dips, cuttings, mountains and wooded areas.
8. The Service may only be used for to internet use/downloading within the Republic of Ireland. If you use your eir Mobile broadband when roaming, you will be charged at a rate of 55c per MB used in EEA countries and 1c per KB used or €10.41 per MB used in all other countries. The Customer can send texts using the Meteor Broadband device. Texts to Irish mobile networks are 12c and texts to international networks are 25c.
9. Customers of the Service cannot avail of any Meteor promotions relating to text messages which are associated with eir Mobile voice plans.
10. The Service data allowance must be used within one month. Unused data cannot be carried over from one billing period to the next.
11. eir reserves the right to vary or amend these terms and conditions or withdraw the Service in whole or in part at any time.
12. Except as expressly provided in these terms and conditions, all conditions, terms, warranties and representations whether express or implied by law in relation to the provision of the Service are excluded to the fullest extent permitted by the applicable law.

13. eir shall not be liable for any loss or damage, direct or indirect, howsoever arising from the Plans or for termination, withdrawal or amending the Plan.
